Picking up Children

Please could we ask that parents come into the Pre-School room via front doors (located within the gated area, where the outdoor toys are placed) as opposed to the usual entrance.

We are then asking parents to leave via the normal exit, so they may pick up any bags and lunch boxes.

This is to avoid congestion on the stairs and also allows staff to supervise the children on the carpet area, ensuring that children go home safely with their parents.



Poorly Children

May we remind parents to observe the 48 hour incubation period (as recommended by the NHS) for any bout of sickness and / or diarrhoea your child may have.

The two day period starts after the symptoms have cleared.

Ignoring this guidance puts other children and staff at risk of infection.

Should a child become poorly during a Pre-School session, staff will notify the relevant parents / carer immediately, with a view to taking the poorly child home.

We appreciate your continued co-operation in this matter.
